The Fast Break

At a Glance: Tonight, Reno looks to best its current season-high-tying six-game winning streak...Last night, **F Marcus Landry** went down with an ankle injury in the first quarter (day-to-day)...tonight will be Reno's last game until 2/25 (All-Star break)...five of Reno's first six games after the break will be played away from the Biggest Little City.

All-Time Series: Tonight's epic battle marks the 5th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and sharpshooter **Brad Miller's Ft. Wayne Mad Ants**...Reno holds the all-time edge, 3-1...the two teams square off three times in the next 21 days, as Reno visits the Hoosier State on 3/3 and 3/4...Ft. Wayne has not defeated Reno since the two teams' first-ever meeting on 12/23/08 in Ft. Wayne (101-92).

Icy A Pattern Here: Reno held Ft. Wayne to just 34.7% from the field last night, the 2nd-best single-game total in franchise history (33.7%, 2/2/11 vs. SPR)...Reno now has held opponents to 50% or worse from the field in 16-straight games...teams have shot a combined 42.9% from the field over that stretch (548-1276)...last night was the 4th time during stretch that Reno has held an opponent under 40% in a game.

We're Going Streaking: Reno is currently riding a season-high-tying 6-game winning streak (also 11/20—12/3)...during streak, the 'Horns have outscored their opponents 644-546 (+98)...average margin of victory is 16.3 ppg...during current streak, Reno has scored 100+ points in 5-of-6 games and held opponents under 100 points in 4-of-6...five of six wins have come by a double-digit margin...the 'Horns also have won 6-straight home games, dating back to 1/15 vs. TEX...also matches a season high for consecutive wins at home (11/20—12/10).

The Gardner Did It: Bighorns **G Thomas Gardner** made his Reno debut last night, scoring 10 points on 3-6 shooting (21 minutes)...also shot 2-4 from beyond the arc...Gardner was acquired from Austin in a three-team trade on 2/1, but was waived due to personal reasons on 2/4 (Idaho received a 3rd round draft pick from Reno; Austin received C Eric Boateng from Idaho)...Gardner had not appeared in a game since 12/30 vs. Tulsa (with Austin)...played in 12 games with Austin (10 starts, 12.4 ppg)...in his 10 starts, Austin went 6-4 (Austin is 6-14 in all other games this season).

Charity Case: The Bighorns set a season high last night by shooting 95.2% (20-21) from the charity stripe...Reno made its first 19 free throws before **G Donald Sloan** split a pair in the last minute of the game...the 'Horns won by 11 points, which was the exact difference in missed free throws last night (Ft. Wayne missed 12, Reno missed 1).

Biggest Little Notes in the World: Last night, the Bighorns improved to 6-1 this season in games in which an NBA assignment player has not appeared...if **F Marcus Landry** does not play tonight (ankle), it will be the first game he will have missed this season...Landry and **G Donald Sloan** are the only Bighorns to have played in all 33 games this season...tonight marks the Bighorns' final game before the All-Star break...last season, Reno went 16-5 in the regular season after the break.

RENO, Nev.—Danny Green scored a game-high 28 points for Reno Friday night, and the Bighorns used a fourth-quarter surge to collect their sixth-straight win, 102-91, over the Fort Wayne Mad Ants in the Reno Events Center.

Fort Wayne (14-18) stayed within striking distance of Reno (21-12) for most of the evening, trailing by five after the first period and just three at the break. Ahead by five through three quarters, the Bighorns came alive in the fourth quarter to cruise to the 11-point victory.

Reno has not lost since Jan. 26, and with the win, the Bighorns improve to 14-3 on the season at home.

Reno's leading scorer, Marcus Landry, was sidelined in the early-going with an ankle injury. Landry logged just two points in four minutes, but the Bighorns rallied behind him and came away with a hard-fought victory.

"It's been an adjustment this whole season in a lot of areas," said Bighorns Head Coach Eric Musselman. "Different guys have stepped up, and tonight was no different."

Green shot 10-of-18 from the field and knocked down all six of his free-throw tries on the way to his highest scoring effort as a Bighorn. Donald Sloan added 15 points and nine assists, Anthony Richardson scored 18 and Patrick O'Bryant finished with 11 boards. Thomas Gardner made his Bighorns debut Friday, chipping-in 10 points off the bench.

The Bighorns hit 20-of-21 free-throw attempts on the night and outrebounded Fort Wayne, 48-45.

The Mad Ants were led by a pair of 21-point efforts by Darnell Lazare and Walker Russell, Jr. Fort Wayne shot 34.7 percent (33-of-95) from the field Friday night, marking the 16th-straight outing Reno has held its opponent below 50 percent from the floor. The Mad Ants shot 63.6 percent (21-of-33) from the free-throw line and 16 percent (4-of-25) from beyond the arc.

"I'm proud of our defense," Musselman said. "Fort Wayne is a team that can score the ball, and we held them to 34 percent. That was a big key for us."
