The Fast Break

At a Glance: Tonight, Reno looks to win its 5th-straight game...current 4-game winning streak is tied for second-longest of the season, after the season-opening 6-game winning streak...all four wins during streak have been by double-digits...6 of the 'Horns next 9 games will be played away from Reno.

All-Time Series: Tonight's epic battle marks the 19th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and **Chandler Moser's Idaho Stampede**...Idaho holds the all-time series lead, 10-8...Reno has won three-straight over Idaho in Boise, and six of the last eight overall...Reno has scored 100 points or more in 15-straight games against Idaho, dating back to 3/19/09.

No Answer for Novak: Newly-acquired **F Steve Novak** tied a team-season-high with five three-pointers last night (also Landry, 3x)...shot 8-10 from the field and 5-7 from three-point range...scored 16 points in the 3rd quarter (4-4 from three-point range)...Novak signed with Reno yesterday morning via the available player pool...the former Houston Rocket, Dallas Maverick and Los Angeles Clipper has shot a career 40.6% from three-point range in 202-career NBA games...shot 3-4 from three-point range in seven games with Dallas this season...before last night, had not seen live game action since 1/1/11 with the Mavericks (at MIL, 3 points in 8 minutes).

Stick With a Winner: Reno's current starting five—Sloan, Green, Landry, Richardson and O'Bryant—is a perfect 4-0...is the 11th lineup that Reno has used this season...no starting five has been together for more than six games...13 different players have started at least one game...no player has started all 31 games (Landry, 30)...Landry is also the only player from the opening day starting lineup that started last night...only Landry and Charlo remain on the active roster from opening night's starting five of Miles, Charlo, Landry, Ewing and Fazekas...just five players remain on the active roster from Reno's opening night roster (Landry, Sloan, Davis, Charlo, Thomas).

Keep'er Under a Hundred: The Bighorns have held their opponents under 100 points in three-straight games and four of their last five...have allowed just 89.4 ppg during that five-game stretch (4-1 record)...Reno is 12-3 on the season when holding opponents to fewer than 100 points...currently allowing 99.1 ppg (one of five teams in league to allow fewer than 100 points per game).

Double-Digit Delight: During Reno's current four-game winning streak, all four wins have come by double digits...since 1/7, Reno's nine wins have come by an average of 16.8 ppg...its five losses during that stretch have come by just 3.0 ppg...on the season, the 'Horns are 11-1 in games decided by 10+ points...just 8-11 in games decided by single digits.

Biggest Little Notes in the World: After tonight, six of Reno's next eight games come against Eastern Conference foes...last night, **F Steve Novak** became the 11th different Bighorn to lead the team in scoring.

BOISE, Idaho—Newcomer Steve Novak poured in a game-high 21 points in his Bighorns debut, leading Reno to a 110-96 victory over the Idaho Stampedede Friday night inside Qwest Arena.

Novak, a five-year NBA veteran who signed with Reno (19-12) earlier today via the available player pool, shot 8-10 from the field and 5-7 from beyond the arc. He led six Bighorns in double figures on the evening, extending Reno's winning streak to four games.

After taking a six-point lead into halftime, Reno extended its lead to 11 by outscoring Idaho (10-18) 29-24 in the third period. Novak scored 16 of his game-high 21 points in the third, leading the 'Horns to their first road win since Jan. 7 at Utah.

NBA assignee Jeremy Lin narrowly missed a double-double, scoring 17 points and adding nine assists. Marcus Landry chipped in with 19 points and six boards for the Bighorns, who defeated Idaho for the third time in four tries this season.

Idaho was led by Antoine Walker's 18 points, while Jermareo Davidson recorded a double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds.
