The Fast Break

At a Glance: Tonight, the Bighorns look to extend their current 5-game win streak and maintain their position at the top of the Western Conference...if the 'Horns win out, they will win the Western Conference and claim the second-overall seed...Reno clinched a playoff berth on March 16 with a victory over Erie...the Bighorns have won 16 of their last 20 games.

All-Time Series: Tonight's epic battle marks the 7th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and **Mack Brown's Austin Toros**...Reno holds the all-time series edge, 4-2...Reno and Austin have split the first two meetings this year, with both games being played in the Cedar Park Center...tonight is Austin's first visit to Reno since Feb. 2-3, 2011...Reno and Austin split that back-to-back...were the only two meetings between the two clubs last season.

March Madness, D-League Style: Entering the final week of the season, Reno leads the Western Conference by one-half game over Tulsa and Rio Grande Valley...the winner of the Western Conference will be the second-overall seed in the playoffs (Iowa has secured #1 overall seed)...if Reno wins out (vs. AUS, vs. BAK, at BAK), it will finish 34-16 and win the Western Conference...seven teams have clinched playoff berths, with four teams vying for the eighth and final spot (FTW, TEX, IDA, AUS)...Ft. Wayne leads Texas by one-half game for the final spot...in the first round of the playoffs, the first, second and third seeds choose their opponent, and the top four seeds earn home-court advantage...the lower seed plays the opening game at home, while the final two games of each series are played at the home court of the higher seed.

Defense Exhibit A: Reno held Dakota to just 82 points in both games of last weekend's series...has held opponent to fewer than 90 points in a game in three-straight and four-of-five...the 'Horns are 11-0 this season when surrendering fewer than 90 points in a contest...they are 1st in the league in opponents points per game (98.5)...one of just three teams to allow fewer than 100 ppg...they are 19-3 when holding opponents below the century mark this season.

Defense Exhibit B: The Bighorns held the 'Force to 38.1% shooting on Saturday, the third-straight game that Reno has held an opponent under 40% from the field...have held opponents under 50% from the field in 28 of last 30 games...during that 30-game stretch, opponents have shot just 42.9% from the field...on the season, Reno leads the D-League in opponents FG% (44.2%).

Close the Deal: The 'Horns have outscored their opponent in the 4th quarter in 7-straight games and 18-of-20 overall...during 20-game stretch, have outscored opponents 538-452 in the final frame (+86 overall, +4.3 ppg)...have gone 16-4 over stretch...on the season, Reno has outscored opponents 1,204-1,130 in the 4th quarter (+74)...highest margin in any one quarter.

Biggest Little Notes in the World: With Saturday's 15-point victory, Reno improved to 17-4 this season in games decided by 10+ points...tonight is Reno's first Tuesday game since 12/28 vs. Tulsa (W, 98-91)...over its last 11 games, Reno has outrebounded its opponent 10 times and tied once...the 'Horns' overall rebounding edge during 11-game stretch is 542-449 (+8.45 rpg).

SIoux FALLS, S.D.—Marcus Landry poured in 27 points and added eight rebounds, lifting Reno to its fifth-straight win and a share of the Western Conference lead, as the 'Horns coasted to a 97-82 victory over Sioux Falls on Saturday night inside the Sioux Falls Arena.

The Bighorns (31-16) have won five-straight games overall and 16 of their last 20. Tonight's win—coupled with Rio Grande Valley's win over Tulsa—puts Reno and Rio Grande Valley in a tie atop the Western Conference with just three games to play. The Western Conference champion is guaranteed the second overall seed and the opportunity to pick their opponent in the first round of the NBA Development League playoffs.

With his 27-point effort tonight, Landry now has eclipsed the 25-point plateau six times this season. Bobby Simmons (17 points, 13 rebounds) and Patrick O'Bryant (12 points, 13 rebounds) added double-doubles for the Bighorns, who held their opponent under 85 points for the third-straight game.

O'Bryant has recorded double-doubles in three-straight games and four of his last five, while Simmons notched his third double-double in his last four contests. Jeremy Lin, on assignment from the Golden State Warriors, added 10 points and eight rebounds for Reno.

Sioux Falls (10-37) was led by Sean Marshall's 15 points and 12 rebounds. Keaton Grant and Stephen McDowell scored in double figures off the bench for the 'Force, chipping in with 11 and 10 points, respectively.
