The Fast Break

At a Glance: Tonight, the Bighorns look to extend their current 6-game win streak and maintain their position at the top of the Western Conference...a win tonight would tie a franchise record for longest winning streak...if the 'Horns win out, they will win the Western Conference and claim the second-overall seed...Reno clinched a playoff berth on March 16 with a victory over Erie...the Bighorns have won 17 of their last 21 games.

All-Time Series: Tonight's epic battle marks the 15th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and **Earl Warren's Bakersfield Jam**...Reno holds the all-time series edge, 9-5...the 'Horns have won 4-of-5 meetings between the two clubs this season, and have won 8-straight home games over the Jam, dating back to 1/10/09...**F Anthony Richardson** has averaged 19.0 ppg this season in 2 games vs. Bakersfield.

Championship In Sight: With just 2 regular season games remaining, Reno holds a 1-game lead in the Western Conference over Rio Grande Valley and Tulsa...if Reno wins both of its remaining games (vs. BAK, at BAK), it will claim its first conference championship in franchise history and the 2nd-overall seed in the 2011 D-League playoffs...Reno holds the tiebreaker over Tulsa, but Rio Grande Valley holds the tiebreaker over Reno...in the event of a three-way tie atop the conference, RGW would finish first, Reno would finish second and Tulsa would finish third based on tiebreaker rules (Reno would have third-overall seed in this scenario).

Keep 'er Under A Hundred: Reno held Austin to just 98 points on Tuesday, marking the fourth-straight game Reno has held an opponent under the century mark (fifth time in six games)...over last 6 games, Reno has held the opposition to just 89.2 ppg (6-0 during stretch)...has held opponent to fewer than 90 points in a game in four of those six games...the 'Horns are 11-0 this season when surrendering fewer than 90 points in a contest and 20-3 when holding opponents under 100 points...they are 1st in the league in opponents points per game (98.5).

The Roaring 30s: The Bighorns held the Toros to 38.4% shooting on Tuesday, the fourth-straight game that Reno has held an opponent under 40% from the field...over four-game stretch, opponents have shot 36.8% from the field (121-329)...on the season, Reno leads the D-League in opponents FG% (44.1%).

Dishing Dimes in Record Numbers: On Tuesday vs. Austin, **G Donald Sloan** set a new Bighorns franchise record by dishing out 15 assists...Reno has had fewer than 15 assists as a team four times this season...previous record of 14 had been shared by Aaron Miles, David Noel and Will Blalock...since Miles went down for the season on 1/5, Sloan has averaged 5.9 apg...has recorded at least 10 assists five times this season, all in the last 30 games...Tuesday also marked Sloan's 7th double-double since taking over for Miles (0 before Miles' injury).

Biggest Little Notes in the World: Last week, the Bighorns earned their 3rd GATORADE Call-Up in franchise history, as **Marketing Partnerships Account Executive Amir Sanjar** took a similar position with the Charlotte Bobcats...both previous GATORADE Call-Ups had gone to the San Antonio Spurs (Steve Novak, Danny Green)...the 'Horns grabbed just 3 offensive rebounds Tuesday, a new season low.

RENO, Nev.—Seven Bighorns registered double figures, and Donald Sloan set a franchise record with 15 assists Tuesday night as Reno topped the Austin Toros, 102-98, in the Reno Events Center.

The Bighorns (32-16) now have won six-straight games and improved to 10-2 in the month of March. With the win, Reno keeps its stranglehold on the Western Conference lead with just two games remaining in the regular season.

On a night where the lead changed hands 10 times, the Bighorns used an 11-0 run in the fourth quarter to flip a five-point deficit into a lead they would not relinquish.

Sloan's 15-assist effort topped the previous single-game franchise mark of 14, which was reached on three occasions by three different players.

Sloan finished with 16 points on the night, while Bobby Simmons registered 19 and Anthony Richardson collected 18. Patrick O'Bryant recorded 13 points and blocked five shots.

Leo Lyons paced the Toros (21-27) with 19 points, and Kyle Weaver finished with 18 before fouling out. Kevin Palmer knocked-down 7-of-8 tries from the free-throw line on his way to 13 points.

Austin out-rebounded Reno 42-to-39 on the night, but the Bighorns held the Toros to just 38.4 percent shooting from the floor.
